Michelman Offers New Coating Product

New Design to Sweed's Dryer Accumulator

Changes to [Sweed Machinery Inc.'s](#) veneer dryer accumulator design has resulted in several innovative features that make it more efficient to run, simpler to operate and easier to maintain for veneer mills, according to a company press release. A major change on Sweed's Accu-Matic is in the accumulator arms. Previously, the arms were indirectly powered via a roller chain. The new design includes direct-driven accumulator arms that are powered by a hydraulic motor and guided by a timed rack and pinion. The change to the direct-drive results in fewer moving parts and less required maintenance.

B&W MEGTEC Supplying Equipment to RoyOMartin

B&W MEGTEC has been selected to design and manufacture environmental equipment for emissions abatement at RoyOMartin's new oriented strand board (OSB) facility in Corrigan, Texas, MEGTEC announced in a press release. B&W MEGTEC will supply complete particulate control, volatile organic compound (VOC) and hazardous air pollutants (HAPs) abatement systems consisting of venturi scrubbers, separators and regenerative thermal oxidizer (RTO) systems. The OSB plant manufactures structural wood paneling for the housing, construction and related industries.

GP Selling Engineered Lumber Business to Boise Cascade

Georgia-Pacific LLC announced December 21 that it has reached an agreement to sell its engineered lumber business to Boise Cascade for \$215 million, including working capital. The transaction is subject to standard regulatory review and other customary closing conditions. Once completed, the sale will include the engineered lumber operations located at Thorsby, Alabama, (approximately 230 employees) and Roxboro, North Carolina (approximately 40 employees), along with a commercial sales and technical team.
