Entry Guidelines

Entries should be new, original and unique items or services that are in field use and producing positive results. All entries are subject to review and approval by EWTA staff. 1. Describe your entry by listing up to two key benefits and any measurable results achieved during use. All fields are required. If a field does not pertain, fill in "none."
2. Limit descriptions to the space provided below.
 - a. The **brief description** and an **image or graphic** are included on the ballot. Limit text to 325 characters/55-60 words. Images must be a .jpg, .png or .pdf.
 - b. **Additional supporting details** on the entry and its use may be included on the EWTA awards webpage.
